

## 2012 Nobel Peace Prize Forum: *The Price of Peace*

The 2012 Nobel Peace Prize Forum is scheduled for March 1-3 in Minneapolis, on the campuses of Augsburg College and the University of Minnesota.

The Nobel Peace Prize Forum is a premier international event designed to inspire peacemaking, broadly defined. As the Norwegian Nobel Institute's only affiliation outside Norway, the Forum has probed the deep questions of peace and conflict for more than 23 years.
